Due diligence – What timber products are regulated?

After 30 November 2014, if you import certain 'regulated timber products' into Australia you will need to assess (and if required mitigate) any risk that they have been illegally logged. This is known as due diligence.

A regulated timber product is timber or timber products listed in Schedule 1 of the *Illegal Logging Prohibition Amendment Regulation 2013.*

The regulated timber products are identified using customs tariff codes, which are based on the Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System. The regulated products fit within Chapters 44, 47, 48 and 94 of the tariff codes and relate to specific wood products, pulp, paper and furniture products.

A full list of regulated timber products is contained on the back of this factsheet.

Are there any exemptions?

The following timber products are exempt from the due diligence requirements:

- a product that is made of recycled material¹, such as waste paper that has been converted to news print or copy paper
- any content of a product that is made of recycled material—which means if you import copy paper that is 50 per cent recycled, you would conduct due diligence on the percentage that is not recycled

- a product imported into Australia as part of a consignment where the combined value of the regulated products in the consignment, on import, does not exceed AUD\$1000. For example, if an importer brings in a shipping container with goods worth AUD\$8000, and in the container there is AUD\$950 worth of a regulated timber product, that importer will not need to undertake due diligence on that import
- packaging material used to support, protect or carry another product.

Frequently asked questions

Q: How do I find out the relevant tariff code for my timber product?

A: If you have imported before, previous import documentation will likely include the relevant tariff code. If you use a customs broker, you may also wish to contact them for this information. The Australian Customs and Border Protection website also provides extensive information on tariff classification (customs.gov.au) and an advice line (1300 363 263).

Q: How will I know if the list of products is updated?

A: The Department of Agriculture's website will be updated to reflect any changes to the list of regulated products. To stay up to date you can join our subscription list by visiting our website at daff.gov.au/illegallogging.

¹ The regulation considers a timber product as recycled material if: the product is substantially made from material that had been, or had been part of, another product; and at the time the material was removed from that other product, the product was no longer used for its intended purpose and was considered to be waste.
